The Victoria and Albert museum struck me the most, I think I could have stayed there for at least 2 hours.

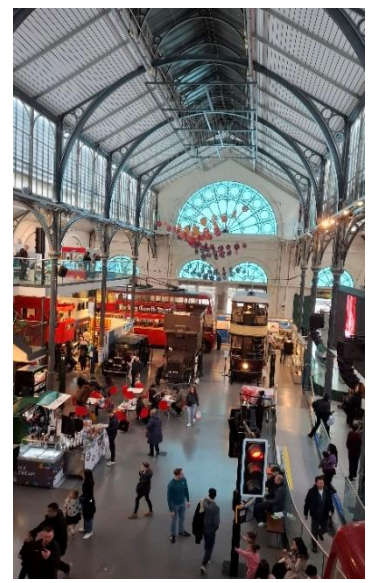
One of the most important part of this trip was the host family, our hosts were really kind and the mother was a really great cook.
